

PREFACE

This special issue of *Discussiones Mathematicae Graph Theory* (DMGT) is dedicated to selected papers presented at the 13th Workshop on Graph Theory: Colourings, Independence and Domination (CID) held on 18–23 September 2009 in Szklarska Poręba, Poland.
